2018/19 INTERNATIONAL COURSE FEES

Please note that the overleaf fees are quoted in GBP (British Pounds) and indicated on an annual basis. For two year courses, you will pay the above indicated fees each year. In addition to the tuition fees above, you may also need to pay Examination Fees and Resource Fees for any additional resources that you may need for your course (materials, books, software etc).

International students need to pay a deposit of £3,000 to secure their place on the course. The full fees for the course needs to be paid at the time of enrolment at college prior to starting their course.

PAYMENT METHOD

Payment of fees can be done by electronic bank transfer. Banks usually charge a fee for this service. You must ensure that you pay the bank charges for both the UK and the overseas bank (in your country) to ensure the total amount transferred to the college is the full fee amount.

REFUNDS

Please note that City and Islington College follows a 'No Refunds' policy which means no refunds are given except for circumstances detailed below:

- ▶ If a visa application has been unsuccessful, deposit fees/ tuition fees paid by the student will be refunded less an administration cost of £100. The student must forward the decision letter from UKVI within 7 days to the International Office
- ▶ Where a student's visa application is refused due to incorrect or false information supplied as part of the student's visa application no refund will be given
- ▶ No refunds are given to students who decide not to enrol or in case of withdrawals
- ▶ In case the college decides not to run the course that the student is enrolled on, a full refund will be given.
