




INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPLETE FIRST AID COURSE

1. Go to <https://www.firstaidforfree.com> and register on the website (this is on the right hand side of their webpage page, see picture). For your username, use your full name as this is what will appear on your certificate when you complete the course.
2. Once you are logged in, scroll to the bottom of the page and you will see a list of online first aid courses you can do. You need to select 'Basic online first aid course' (see below) from this list and then work your way through the modules.



3. It is important that when you have read through and completed a section you select the green 'marked as complete' button found at the bottom of the page otherwise the package will assuming you still have to complete the section.



4. Once you have completed all modules and passed the mini-tests at the end of each one, you will be given the option to download your first aid certificate (remember, all sections must be marked as completed for this to happen).
